RESOLUTION No. 976

Adopted by The Sacramento City Council on date of

September 19, 1969

That WARDLEY CORPORATION, a wholly owned subsidiary of the Hong Kong and Shanghai Banking Corporation of California, 180 Sansome Street, San Francisco, California, is hereby granted a revocable permit to install pile caps extending into the public right of way of J Street.

The property is more particularly described as follows:

The northerly one foot (1') of J Street right of way between 63 feet and 64 feet north of the center line of J Street and extending from a point 135 feet west of the center line of 5th Street to a point 72 feet west of the center line of 5th Street.

This permit is granted with the following conditions:

- 1. Permittee shall determine the location of and protect and support all utilities in the public rights of way and shall bear the entire cost of any necessary relocation or reconstruction made necessary by reason of settlement or damage to utilities.
- 2. That permittee shall protect and save the City of Sacramento harmless from all damages, costs, and causes of action in connection with the granting of this permit.
- 3. The provisions of this permit shall apply to and be binding upon the permittee, its successors and assigns, and permittee agrees not to transfer its property without notifying the transferee of the provisions and obligations of this permit.
