

ORDINANCE NO. 1533, FOURTH SERIES

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO PURCHASE PLUMBING SUPPLIES AND HAVE CERTAIN PLUMBING WORK DONE AT WILLIAM LAND PARK BY CITY FORCES WITHOUT FIRST ADVERTISING FOR BIDS, PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 251 OF THE CITY CHARTER, AND MAKING THIS ORDINANCE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE TO TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to purchase certain plumbing supplies in the open market and also to have certain plumbing work done by City forces, in William Land Park, consisting of plumbing work for the improvement of the water system within the park. Such supplies and work to be accomplished without first advertising for bids, pursuant to the provisions of Section 251 of the City Charter. The estimated cost for the completion of the work is \$2,000.00.

SECTION 2. That this ordinance is hereby made an emergency measure and shall take effect immediately; such emergency being the necessity of making improvements in the water system for the complete use and enjoyment of the Park by the citizens of this City.
