

## **RESOLUTION NO. 2019-0053**

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council

February 12, 2019

### **Trail Naming of the West Drain Canal and Creekside Canal**

#### **BACKGROUND**

- A. Two trails in North Natomas which are currently unnamed but are generally known as the West Drain Canal Trail and the Creekside Trail provide approximately 3.6 miles collectively of off-street multi-use trails for bicycle and pedestrian travel in the North Natomas area.
- B. Community outreach was conducted with a trail naming campaign and survey. The names “Fisherman’s Lake Parkway” and “Redbud Trail” received the strongest community support.
- C. On August 23, 2018, the Active Transportation Commission forwarded a recommendation to the City Council supporting naming these trails “Fisherman’s Lake Parkway” and “Redbud Trail”.
- D. Naming the trail is consistent with the City of Sacramento Facility Naming Policy adopted by City Council on February 26, 2008 (Resolution 2008-0112).

#### **BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:**

- Section 1. Trail #1 known as the West Drain Canal Trail shall be named Fisherman’s Lake Parkway for the entirety of the trail length, inclusive of future gap closure development, as shown in Exhibit A.
- Section 2. Trail #2 known as the Creekside Trail shall be named Redbud Trail for the entirety of the trail length as shown in Exhibit A.

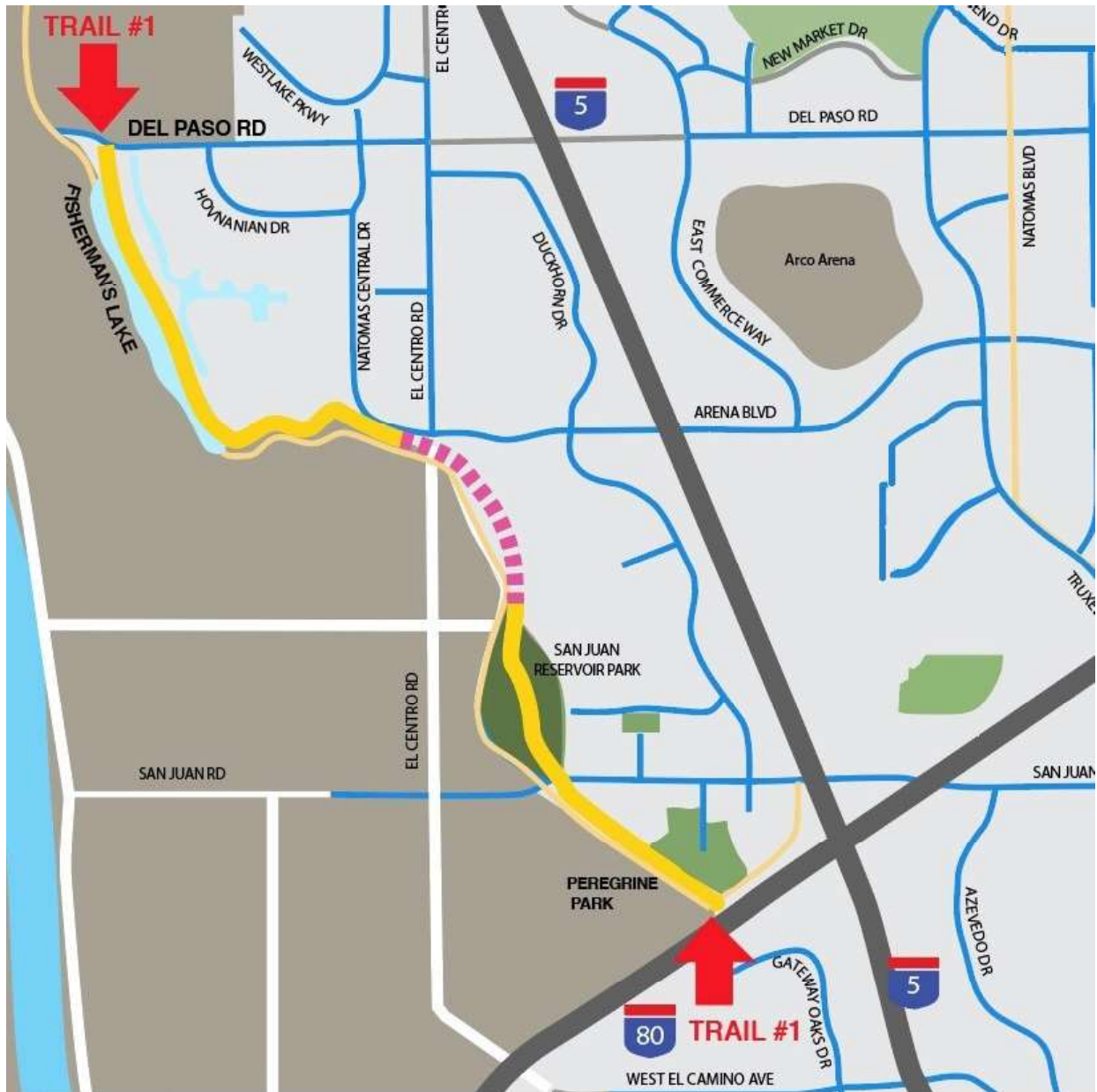

## Exhibit A Trail Map

Figure 1: Trail #1 known as the West Drain Canal Trail originates from Fisherman's Lake at Del Paso Road and runs south on the westside of North Natomas. Future plans will complete this 3.5-mile path (uncompleted section marked with a dashed line on map) all the way to South Natomas.

Figure 2: Trail #2 known as the Creekside Trail is a 1-mile trail that runs north-south between East Commerce Drive and North Park Drive, traveling through Valley Oak Park and Redbud Park.
