

ORDINANCE NO. 1060, FOURTH SERIES.

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING OUT OF THE REVENUES OF THE FISCAL YEAR COMMENCING JULY 1, 1945, THE AMOUNTS NECESSARY TO MEET THE EXPENDITURES OF THE CITY BASED ON THE BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR COMMENCING JULY 1, 1945, SUBMITTED BY THE CITY MANAGER, AND MAKING THIS AN EMERGENCY MEASURE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1: There is hereby appropriated, out of the revenues of the fiscal year commencing July 1, 1945, amounts sufficient to meet the expenditure requirements of the City in the amounts and for the purposes set forth in the budget submitted for the fiscal year 1945-46 by the City Manager and as determined and adopted by the City Council.

SECTION 2: This ordinance, being one appropriating money, is hereby made an emergency measure as provided by the Charter.
