

Resolution of Award No. 2123

Resolved, that the City Council of the City of Sacramento, having in open session on the 28th day of October, 1926, opened, examined, and publicly declared all sealed proposals or bids offered for the doing of the street work hereinafter mentioned,

Hereby rejects all of said bids, except that next hereinafter mentioned, and hereby awards the contract for said work to the lowest regular, responsible bidder, to-wit:

at the prices specified in his proposal for said work now on file.

The work herein referred to is the improvement of **the alley between 35th and 36th Streets, from the southerly line of 4th Avenue to the northerly line of 5th Avenue.**

in the City of Sacramento to the extent, with the materials and in the manner set forth in Resolution of Intention No. 2123, passed and adopted by said City Council on September 23, 1926, reference to which Resolution of Intention is hereby made for a description of said work and improvement.
