Solon Wisham, Assistant City Manager, gave a brief overview of this item. He said that it was basically a question and answer session on the expansion of the Exhibit Hall Facility. He explained that Phase I would be to acquire the land and title.

Sam Burns, Director of the Community Center, stated that the Center was at its saturation point. He said that 100,000 square feet of expansion would be enough until the year 2000.

Councilmember Chinn wanted to see if it were possible to accomodate some small businesses on the 1st floor.


Councilmember Robie emphasized that this structure would not be soley used for out of town needs.

The Committee said that it would like to hear both Memorial Auditorium and the Exhibit Hall Expansion at the same time.

Tim Holt, a citizen, stated that he would like stronger support and priority given to small businesses and the future needs for small business people.

Moved by Committee Member Shore to direct staff to bring this project back in a more refined package at the same time as the Memorial Auditorium reuse issue. Staff was also directed to look at incorporating small business in the design of the building.
