

RESOLUTION No. 136

Adopted by The Sacramento City Council on date of

February 7th, 1929

APPORTIONING THE ENTERTAINMENT AND ADVERTISING FUND

WHEREAS, this Council budgeted the sum of \$20,000.00 under Section 90 of the Charter for the Entertaining and Advertising Fund; and

WHEREAS, this fund is unapportioned as to the particular purposes of expenditure,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

That said fund be apportioned as follows:

\$6,000.00 to Tourist and Convention Bureau.
 \$4,000.00 to Sacramento Regional Citizens Council.
 \$5,000.00 to State Fair.
 \$4,000.00 to Sacramento Chamber of Commerce.
 \$1,000.00 to Miscellaneous purposes, as Independence Day, Memorial Day, Armistice Day, etc.
