

ORDINANCE NO. 1250, FOURTH SERIES.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 41 OF ORDINANCE NO. 1214, FOURTH SERIES, PASSED SEPTEMBER 27, 1947, AND ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE USE OF TAXICABS, AUTOMOBILES AND PUBLIC VEHICLES FOR HIRE, FIXING THE RATE TO BE CHARGED FOR THE TRANSPORTATION OF PERSONS AND PERSONAL BAGGAGE, AND THE LICENSE FOR SOLICITING SUCH TRANSPORTATION, PROVIDING A PUNISHMENT FOR ANY VIOLATION THEREOF, AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH," AND MAKING THIS ORDINANCE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE TO TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF

SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1: Section 41 of Ordinance No. 1214, Fourth Series, passed September 27, 1947, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 41: Notwithstanding any of the provisions of this ordinance, owners and drivers may operate taxicabs without the installations of taximeters until April 1, 1947. Until said date zone rates or taximeter rates shall apply at the discretion of the owner licensed hereunder. After April 1, 1947, the operation of taxicabs without taximeters shall be unlawful.

SECTION 2: This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect immediately, such emergency being that taximeters are not available for installation.
