

ORDINANCE NO. 1009, FOURTH SERIES.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 304, FOURTH SERIES, PASSED NOVEMBER 12, 1926, AND ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE REGULATING TRAVEL, TRAFFIC AND PARKING UPON THE STREETS AND OTHER PUBLIC PLACES LAID OUT FOR THE USE OF VEHICLES AND PEDESTRIANS IN THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO; DEFINING THE TERMS USED IN THIS ORDINANCE, CREATING CERTAIN TRAFFIC DISTRICTS IN THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO; FIXING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE, AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 80, FOURTH SERIES, PASSED JUNE 22ND, 1922; AND ALL ORDINANCES AMENDATORY THEREOF, BY ADDING A NEW SECTION THERETO, TO BE NUMBERED 31-3, AND MAKING THIS AN EMERGENCY MEASURE TO TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF

SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1: Ordinance No. 304, Fourth Series, passed November 12, 1926, is hereby amended by adding a new section thereto to be numbered 31-3:

PARKING IN NEW HELVETIA HOUSING PROJECT

Section 31-3: It shall be unlawful for any person to leave standing or cause or permit to leave standing any vehicle upon Warner Street, Revere Street, Kemble Street, Ringgold Street, Kit Carson Street or Marsh Street, which streets are located in the "New Helvetia Housing Project", in the City of Sacramento and are named and described in Ordinance No. 954, Fourth Series.

SECTION 2: This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect immediately; such emergency being that parking of vehicles on the streets mentioned in this ordinance has recently caused a fire hazard by preventing ready access to the buildings of the New Helvetia Housing Project by the fire equipment of the City of Sacramento.
