SUBJECT: Metropolitan Arts Division - Authorization to Submit Grant Application under the California Arts Council's Local Organization Development Program

SUMMARY

This report recommends authorization for the Metropolitan Arts Division to submit a grant application to the California Arts Council in the amount of EIGHTEEN THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$18,000) for the purpose of contracting an individual for twelve months to develop alternative sources of funding for the activities of the Commission.

BACKGROUND

During the past three years, the Commission has seen a rapid development and growth of its programs and activities. This has been made possible through a variety of funding sources with the City and County General Funds providing the base of support. In addition to General Fund support, other sources of funding which provide for programmatic activities and personnel are CETA, grants, and corporate contributions.

In order for these programs to develop and grow, it is necessary for the Commission to not only continue to cultivate the already existing funding sources, but to develop new and innovative ways of seeking financial stability through fees for services, government contracts, corporate contributions and fundraising events.

FINANCIAL DATA

The grant does not require additional City or County funds. However, a (50%) match is required in funds other than state monies. The Metro Arts Division intends to match the grant amount through existing staff salaries.
