## RESOLUTION OPPOSING PROPOSITION 9 (JARVIS II)

WHEREAS, Proposition 9, also known as Jarvis II, will be voted upon at the statewide primary election to be held on June 3, 1980; and

WHEREAS, Proposition 9 would reduce the state personal income tax by fifty percent - in such a fashion to insure that the wealthiest taxpayers would garner the biggest savings; and

WHEREAS, the state Legislative Analyst estimates that the revenue loss if Proposition 9 is approved would be approximately 4.9 billion dollars for 1980-1981; and

WHEREAS, the approval of Proposition 9 will result in a substantial reduction in state funds which are presently paid to cities under state law and needed for essential services,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO that the City Council opposes Proposition 9.
