SUBJECT: APPROVAL OF MAINTENANCE AGREEMENT EXTENSION (CHANGE ORDER) FOR WASTE HAULING IN SUPPORT OF MINOR STREET REPAIRS WITH D & N ASSOCIATES INC. FOR AN AMOUNT OF \$100,000

RECOMMENDATION:

This report recommends that the City Council:

- Adopt the attached resolution which authorizes the City Manager to execute an extension to the contract for Waste Hauling In Support Of Minor Street Repairs (JN:8014) with D & N Associates Inc.
- Approve a maintenance agreement extension with the D & N Associates Inc. for an amount of \$100,000.

SUMMARY:

The Maintenance Services Division of the Department of Public Works annually spends up to \$200,000 for Waste Hauling In Support Of Minor Street Repairs (JN:8014) to provide waste removal services to the Maintenance Services Division when making minor street repairs. Currently we have two contractors, Bob's Trucking and D & N Associates Inc. whose contracts were awarded under the formal bidding process.

COMMITTEE/COMMISSION ACTION:

None.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

- The Maintenance Services Division has the need for Waste Hauling services on every street repair job.
- Waste Hauling firms were solicited in August of 1999 using standard City Request for Proposal procedures to provide Waste Hauling In Support Of Minor Street Repairs.
- The contract for Waste Hauling is from the date of award through June 30, 2001 with the option of extending the contract on a year-to-year however, in no case will the extended renewals extend beyond June 30, 2002.

FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS:

The contract is for a "not to exceed" amount of \$100,000 for each annual period. The costs for the services provided are included in each street repair job.

ENVIRONMENTAL CONSIDERATIONS:

Pursuant to Section 15060(c)(2), of the California Environmental Quality Act Guidelines, this is not a project under the California Environmental Quality Act because the subject waste hauling activities will not result in any physical change in the environment.


POLICY CONSIDERATIONS:

This action is consistent with City Code Title 3.64.

ESBD CONSIDERATIONS:

Due to the nature of this agreement, it will not affect the ESBD requirements. Maintenance Services is committed to these ESBD requirements, is currently working with the OSBD, and is presently exceeding the Council's twenty percent requirements through various other contracts and agreements.


