

RESOLUTION No. 67

Adopted by The Sacramento City Council on date of

RESOLUTION APPROPRIATING MONEY RECEIVED FROM SALE OF ABANDONED STEEL RAILS.

WHEREAS, the City, as a W.P.A. Project, is tearing up steel rails formerly used as a street car track now abandoned, and selling them to the Bethlehem Steel Corporation and the Columbia Steel Company, under instructions from the O.P.M., and

WHEREAS, the City has agreed to finance this Project with money received from said sales and whatever is necessary from other funds, and

WHEREAS, the City Controller advises that this money so received must go into the General Fund,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

That all money so received from the sale of said steel rails shall be, and the same is hereby, appropriated for use in financing such Project.


~~BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the same situation applies to the sale of the old ties in said tracks, and the same disposition shall be made of the proceeds.~~
