

ORDINANCE NO. 1599, FOURTH SERIES

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF TEN THOUSAND DOLLARS TO COVER PERSONAL SERVICES FOR EMPLOYEES WHO HAVE ENTERED MILITARY SERVICE AND ARE ENTITLED TO PAYMENT FOR MILITARY LEAVE UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THE MILITARY AND VETERANS CODE OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA, AND MAKING THIS ORDINANCE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE TO TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1: That there is hereby appropriated the sum of Ten Thousand (\$10,000.00) Dollars out of the unappropriated reserve to the various departments of the City, to cover personal services for payment of military leave to employees in the military reserve pursuant to the provisions of the Military and Veterans Code of the State of California.

SECTION 2: That this ordinance is hereby declared an emergency measure and shall take effect immediately; such emergency being the necessity of payment of sums for military leave payable to employees in the military service of the Government, in accordance with the provisions of the Military and Veterans Code, as amended by Chapter 1561, Statutes of 1951, effective July 16, 1951.
