

ORDINANCE NO. 1496, FOURTH SERIES.

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO HAVE CERTAIN WORK DONE AT THE WILLIAM LAND ZOO WITHOUT FIRST ADVERTISING FOR BIDS, PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 251 OF THE CITY CHARTER, AND MAKING THIS ORDINANCE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE TO TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1: The City Manager is hereby authorized to have the following work done at the William Land Zoo, to-wit:


Construction of a chain link steel fence and gates to protect the pen now under construction at the William Land Zoo for housing the Chimpanzie soon to be acquired,

without advertising for bids, pursuant to the provisions of Section 251 of the City Charter. The estimated cost to be \$1400.00.

SECTION 2: This ordinance is hereby made an emergency measure and shall take effect immediately; such emergency being that there is not sufficient time within which to complete specifications and submit them to bid, as this work must be completed at the sametime the work of constructing the pen is completed.
