

# RESOLUTION NO. 90-059

ADOPTED BY THE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO

DETERMINATION THAT THE USE OF TAXES ALLOCATED FROM THE RICHARDS BOULEVARD REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A PUBLICLY OWNED BUILDING, FACILITY OR STRUCTURE WILL BE OF BENEFIT TO THE PROJECT AND THE IMMEDIATE NEIGHBORHOOD (SECTION 33679 CRA)

WHEREAS, the Redevelopment Agency of the City of Sacramento ("Agency") has prepared a proposed Redevelopment Plan for the Richards Boulevard Redevelopment Project ("Project") which, if adopted, will result in the allocation of tax increment revenues from the Project to the Agency for purposes of redevelopment; and

WHEREAS, the Agency proposes to enter into an agreement with the County of Sacramento under which the agency would use such tax increment revenues to pay the County over a period of years for the cost of construction of a publicly owned building, facility or structure to be located within the Project area; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Sacramento ("City Council") on July 2, 1990, held a public hearing for the purpose of receiving public input and comment on the proposed agreement, and at the conclusion of such hearing, adopted Resolution No. 90-583, consenting to such agreement and making the determinations received by Section 33445 of the California Health and Safety Code; and

WHEREAS, in connection with making the above determinations, the City Council considered the information contained in a summary report prepared by the Agency pursuant to Section 33679 of the California Health and Safety Code.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

Section 2: Based further on the information contained in the Agency's summary report, the Agency hereby further determines that no other reasonable means of financing such building, facility or structure are available to the community.
