Adopted by The Sacramento City Council on date of

April 23, 1936

RESOLUTION CANCELLING TAXES

WHEREAS, the application of the City of Sacramento for cancellation of the taxes upon the real property hereinafter described, now owned by said City, having been presented; and

IT APPEARING that, under and by virtue of Section 3804-a Political Code, said taxes, including current taxes, should be cancelled;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

That said taxes be cancelled.


The real property upon which said taxes are so cancelled is situated in the City of Sacramento, County of Sacramento, State of California, and is described as follows:

LOT 31 "WRIGHT & KIMBROUGH COLLEGE PLAZA TRACT"

(as the same is shown on the official map or plat thereof filed in the office of the County Recorder of the County of Sacramento, State of California)

The taxes hereinbefore referred to are hereby made to include all of the amounts shown on the delinquent rolls in the City Controller's office; and the current (1935-1936) installments of the taxes now due and payable in the office of the City Collector.
