

ORDINANCE NO. 2063 FOURTH SERIES

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 1570, FOURTH SERIES, PASSED MARCH 8, 1951, AND ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE REGULATING TRAFFIC, TRAVEL AND PARKING UPON THE STREETS AND OTHER PUBLIC PLACES LAID OUT FOR THE USE OF VEHICLES AND PEDESTRIANS IN THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO. DEFINING THE TERMS USED IN THIS ORDINANCE, CREATING CERTAIN TRAFFIC DISTRICTS IN THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO, FIXING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 304, FOURTH SERIES, AND ALL OTHER ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH" BY ADDING A NEW SECTION TO BE NUMBERED 34D (REGULATING TRAFFIC IN SACRAMENTO MUNICIPAL AIRPORT).

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 1570, FOURTH SERIES, passed March 8, 1951, is hereby amended by adding a new Section thereto to be numbered 34d, to read as follows:

Section 34d. The provisions of this ordinance shall apply to vehicular traffic upon the roads within the Sacramento Municipal Airport in the same manner and to the same extent as if these roads were public roads, and the provisions of this ordinance shall apply, when applicable, to standing, stopping, and parking of vehicles and the enforcement thereof shall be as provided in this ordinance.

The city traffic engineer is hereby authorized, subject to the provisions and limitations of this ordinance, to:

Install traffic control devices, erect and maintain stop signs and signs regulating or prohibiting stopping, standing and parking; establish and mark pedestrian walks and parking zones and establish speed limits within the Sacramento Municipal Airport. It is also the duty of the traffic division of the City Police Department to enforce the provisions of this ordinance within the Sacramento Municipal Airport in the same manner and to the same extent as the provisions thereof concerning other roads within the City.

Violations of any of the provisions of this section shall constitute a misdemeanor and shall be punishable as provided in Section 125 hereof.

SECTION 2. This ordinance is hereby made an emergency measure and shall take effect immediately; such emergency being that traffic in the airport is not observing and obeying the presently posted signs, causing danger to traffic, and is appropriating parking space for unlimited periods of time.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be published once in the "SACRAMENTO UNION," a newspaper of general circulation, printed in the City of Sacramento and also the official newspaper of said City.
