Approving Park Naming of Richfield Park as LeVar Burton Park

BACKGROUND

- A. Richfield Park is a 3.14-acre park located at 1900 Expedition Way in South Area (Council District 8).
- B. On February 7, 2019, the Parks and Recreation Commission considered and supported the recommendation of naming Richfield Park as LeVar Burton Park.
- C. LeVar Burton contributes significantly to the community by using his career and influence to promote education and literacy.
- D. Naming LeVar Burton Park is consistent with the City of Sacramento Facility Naming Policy adopted by the City Council on February 26, 2008 (Resolution No. 2008-0112).
- E. Utilizing funds from the Park Impact Fee Fund (Fund 3204) is appropriate for this improvement.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The park name for Richfield Park as “LeVar Burton Park” is hereby approved.
- Section 2. The City Manager or the City Manager’s designee is authorized to appropriate \$20,000 from the Park Impact Fee Fund Available Fund Balance (Fund 3204) to Richfield Park Playground L19154100.
