SUBJECT: Art in Public Places - Transfer of Capital Improvement Project
Appropriations - McClatchy Pool to Oak Park Community Center

SUMMARY

This report recommends an \$11,696 transfer of Capital Improvement Appropriations of Art in Public Places funds from the McClatchy Pool Project to the Oak Park Community Center Project. Both projects are within the Oak Park PAC area.

BACKGROUND

Pursuant to City Code 2.59 (c), 2% of the construction costs of each project were allocated for artwork.

The Oak Park PAC Art Committee studied the needs for an artwork at the Oak Park Community Center and felt that the \$12,528 balance was not sufficient to make the kind of statement they wanted. In addition, the committee members felt that the McClatchy Park Pool (\$11,696 balance) was too confined and too finished a space for a contemporary work of art. They, therefore, recommended to the entire Oak Park PAC that the McClatchy Park Pool art funds be added to those at the Community Center to make one significant art statement. The Oak Park PAC approved this recommendation as did, subsequently, the Sacramento Metropolitan Arts Commission.

FINANCIAL DATA

There are no additional City funds required. This is a transfer of appropriations between different Capital Improvement Projects.

A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE CITY CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT BUDGET FOR FY 1981-82 FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY SERVICES BY \$11,696 (McCLATCHY POOL AND OAK PARK COMMUNITY CENTER)

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Sacramento:

1. The Art in Public Places appropriation for the McClatchy Park Pool Project is to be expended with the Oak Park Community Center Project funding as one artwork project within the Oak Park PAC area.

2. The City budget for FY 1981-82 is hereby amended:

by transferring \$11,696 from the McClatchy Park Pool Budget No. 2-11-2240-2187-4820 to the Oak Park Community Center Budget No. 2-11-2240-2215-4860 for the purpose stated in Paragraph 1 above.
