**Notice to Lobbyists:** When addressing the Sacramento Metropolitan Arts Commission, you must identify yourself as a lobbyist and announce the client/business/organization you are representing (City Code 2.15.160).

**Speaker slips are located in the lobby of the hearing room and should be completed and submitted to the Sacramento Metropolitan Arts Commission Clerk.**

*Government Code 54950 (The Brown Act) requires that a brief description of each item to be transacted or discussed be posted at least 72 hours prior to a regular meeting. The City posts Agendas at City Hall as well as offsite meeting locations.*

The order of agenda items are listed for reference and may be taken in any order deemed appropriate by the Commission. The Agenda provides a general description and staff recommendations; however, the Commission may take action other than what is recommended.
