WHEREAS, the City by grant deed conveyed to Louis L. Watson, Lot 704 Swanston Park, Unit No. 2, in said city, and

WHEREAS, said deed contained certain restrictive covenants coupled with reversionary rights reserved in favor of the grantor, and

WHEREAS, the grantee is building a house thereon with a loan from the Veterans' Welfare Board of the State of California, and

WHEREAS, said Veterans' Welfare Board desires that there be assigned to it the reversionary rights of the City, and


WHEREAS, under the circumstances, it is perfectly right and proper that said Welfare Board have such reversionary rights

LOT 680 "SWANSTON PARK, UNIT NO. 2"


(as the same is shown on the official map or plat thereof filed in the office of the County Recorder of the County of Sacramento, State of California)
