**RESOLUTION SUSPENDING COMPETITIVE BIDDING  
AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER AND CITY CLERK  
TO EXECUTE THE MICROSOFT STATE AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT  
ENTERPRISE ENROLLMENT IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE CCISDA ENTERPRISE  
AGREEMENT FOR THE LICENSING OF MICROSOFT PRODUCTS**

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO THAT:**

1. In the best interest of the City of Sacramento, competitive bidding is hereby suspended for the purchase of Microsoft products and licenses. Under the California Counties Information System Directors Association (CCISDA), a competitive bidding process for Microsoft Enterprise Agreement was conducted. One of the CCISDA's selected Microsoft product resellers for the Microsoft Enterprise Agreement was CompuCom, which will be used to purchase Microsoft products for an amount not to exceed \$500,000 annually for a five-year period.
2. The City Manager and City Clerk are hereby authorized to execute the Microsoft State and Local Government Enterprise Enrollment in accordance with the California Counties Information System Directors Association Enterprise Agreement, for the licensing of Microsoft products.
