Session #4 Regional Transit Staff Presentation

SUMMARY

At the City Council's request, City staff began a series of North Natomas briefing sessions with the Joint Committees in October 1990. A presentation will be made by Regional Transit staff on March 5th concerning transit facilities and service planning. These informational sessions are nearing a conclusion and the next step begins which is to discuss whether Plan Amendments are needed, and if so in what areas. Staff's anticipated timetable for future sessions is outlined in the background section of this report.

- Session 5: Presentation by Public Works on a recommended financing plan (tentatively scheduled for March 12, 1991)
- Session 6: Discussion of potential study areas for Plan Amendments, a preliminary list will be prepared by staff (scheduled for late March, 1991)


