KEY CLUB WEEK November 5-11, 2000

WHEREAS, Key Club International, the largest high school service organization, sponsored by Kiwanis International, is observing the first full week in November as Key Club Week; and

WHEREAS, the members of the Key Club of Sacramento are part of an international organization of over 215,000 students dedicated to serve with purpose their homes, schools, and communities, seeking to give primacy to the human and spiritual rather than the material values of life; and

WHEREAS, Sacramento High School Key Club is the original club, established in 1925, it just celebrated its 75th Birthday, and the following other High Schools have an active Key Club: Christian Brothers, J.F. Kennedy, St. Francis, Laguna Creek, C.K. McClatchy and Florin; and

WHEREAS, they promote the adoption of higher standards in scholastics, sportsmanship, and social contacts and the development of a more concerned citizenship; and


WHEREAS, each member will perform at least 50 hours of service to their home, school and community annually; and

WHEREAS, the ongoing Major Emphasis Program, "Children: Their Future/Our Focus," focuses on helping children develop personally, and learn to socially interact; and
