

RESOLUTION NO. 2007-680

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council

September 11, 2007

APPROVING THE MEMORIAL AUDITORIUM LIGHTING AND LANDSCAPE PLAN APPROVAL PC71

BACKGROUND:

- A. On March 27, 2007 City Council directed staff to proceed with the City's plan to complete the foundation waterproofing, landscape, and lighting projects needed at the Memorial Auditorium.
- B. Landscaping will be required once the waterproofing is completed and will be integrated with another known need, the exterior lighting project.
- C. The Lighting and Landscape Plan has been developed with input from a community advisory committee, historic preservation, and ADA professionals.
- D. There are adequate funds in the Capital Improvement Program (PC71) to complete the Lighting and Landscape plan.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Memorial Auditorium Lighting and Landscape Plan is approved.

Section 2. Staff is directed to move forward with implementing the approved Plan.




