

RESOLUTION No. 16

Adopted by The Sacramento City Council on date of
February 23, 1934


WHEREAS, Arthur E. Miller, James McGillivray and William O. Cullen and Bessie Brown Cullen have conveyed to the City of Sacramento certain real property, said real property being a small triangular tract bounded by Freeport Boulevard on the west, Western Pacific Railroad on the east and Hillcrest Subdivision on the south, a particular description of which is set out in the deeds hereto attached.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

That the said deeds be, and the same are hereby accepted; that the City Clerk is hereby directed to attach a certified copy of this resolution to said deeds and record same in the office of the County Recorder.
