FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENT FOR ENVIRONMENTAL SERVICES WITH GAIL ERVIN CONSULTING SERVICES

BACKGROUND

- A. After a competitive selection process, the City entered into a Consulting and Professional Services Agreement #2005-1219 with Gail Ervin Consulting (GEC) to prepare an Environmental Impact Report for the 800 K/L project for a not-to-exceed amount of \$99,985.50.
- B. At the time, it was not anticipated that an extraordinary amount of time would be needed for GEC to coordinate responses to particularly extensive comments received during the public comment period for the Draft Environmental Impact Report.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager is authorized to execute Supplemental Agreement Number 1 to City Agreement No. 2005-1219 for environmental services with Gail Ervin Consulting Services increasing the not-to-exceed amount by \$4,900 for a total contract amount of \$104,855.50.
