

RESOLUTION ACCEPTING DEDICATION BY SACRAMENTO CITY SCHOOL DISTRICT OF EAST TWENTY (20) FEET OF EL DORADO SCHOOL SITE FOR STREET AND HIGHWAY PURPOSES AND ESTABLISHING 53rd STREET ALONG THE EAST SIDE OF SAID EL DORADO SCHOOL SITE NORTH OF "J" STREET TO A WIDTH OF FORTY (40) FEET.

WHEREAS, Sacramento City School District has dedicated twenty (20) feet along the East boundary of the El Dorado School Site for street purposes, conditioned upon the City of Sacramento establishing 53rd Street along the East boundary of said School Site to a width of forty (40) feet,

IT IS THEREFORE RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

That the dedication by said Sacramento City School District of a strip of land twenty (20) feet in width entirely along the East side of El Dorado School Site for street purposes, be, and the same is hereby accepted;

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that 53rd Street, in the City of Sacramento, from the North boundary of "J" Street entirely along the East boundary of El Dorado School Site and to the connection of said 53rd Street with the next street running East and West North of "J" Street, be, and the same is hereby established to a width of forty (40) feet, including the Twenty (20) foot strip heretofore appearing on the Official Maps of the City of Sacramento as 53rd Street North of "J" Street, and also the Twenty (20) foot strip so dedicated by the said Sacramento City School District for street purposes.
