

RESOLUTION No. 541

Adopted by The Sacramento City Council on date of
February 20, 1948

WHEREAS, the establishment of the following streets as arterial streets is deemed necessary for the protection of the traveling public,

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

That pursuant to Section 23 of Ordinance No. 304, Fourth Series, as amended by Ordinance No. 810, Fourth Series, the following streets are hereby designated as arterial streets:

ALHAMBRA BOULEVARD, from the south side of Broadway to the north City Limit;

BROADWAY, from the Sacramento River to the East City Limit;

CAPITOL AVENUE, from the west side of Front Street to the east side of Ninth Street, and from the west side of Sixteenth Street to the east side of Alhambra Boulevard;

"E" STREET, from the west side of Seventh Street to the east side of Alhambra Boulevard;

FOLSOM BOULEVARD, from the east side of Alhambra Boulevard to the east City Limit;

FRANKLIN BOULEVARD, from the south side of Broadway to the south City Limit;

FREEPORT BOULEVARD, from the south side of Broadway to the west side of Twenty-first Street;

"H" STREET, from the west side of Sixth Street to the east City Limit;

"J" STREET, from the east side of Sixteenth Street to the east side of Fifty-eighth Street.

"L" STREET, from the west side of Thirteenth Street to the west side of Alhambra Boulevard;

LAND PARK DRIVE, from the south side of Broadway to the south side of Thirteenth Avenue;

McKINLEY BOULEVARD, from the east side of Alhambra Boulevard to the south side of Elvas Avenue;

"N" STREET, from the west side of Ninth Street to the west side of Sixteenth Street.

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NINTH STREET, from the south side of "L" Street
to the north side of Broadway;

"P" STREET, from the west side of Front Street
to the west side of Alhambra Boulevard;

RIVERSIDE BOULEVARD, from the south side of Broadway
to the south City Limit;

SACRAMENTO BOULEVARD, from the south side of Broadway
to south City Limit;

SECOND AVENUE, from the east side of Riverside
Boulevard to the west side of Stockton
Boulevard;

SEVENTH STREET, from the south side of "E" Street
to the north side of "H" Street;

SIXTEENTH STREET, from the north side of Broadway
to the north City Limit;

STOCKTON BOULEVARD, from the east line of Alhambra
Boulevard at "P" Street to the south City
Limit;

SUTTERVILLE ROAD, from the east side of Freeport
Boulevard to the center line of Franklin
Boulevard;

"T" STREET, from the west side of Front Street to
the east side of Fifty-eighth Street;

THIRTY-FOURTH STREET, from the south side of
Folsom Boulevard to the north side of
Fifth Avenue;

THIRTY-NINTH STREET, from the south side of Folsom
Boulevard to the north-east side of
Stockton Boulevard;

TWELFTH AVENUE, from the center line of Franklin
Boulevard to the west side of Stockton
Boulevard;

TWELFTH STREET, from the south side of "H" Street
to the north City Limit;

TWENTY-EIGHTH STREET, from the south side of "J":
Street to the north side of Broadway.

TWENTY-FIRST STREET AND FREEPORT BOULEVARD, from
the north side of "H" Street to the south
City Limit;

MUIR WAY, from the south side of Broadway to the
north line of Swanson Drive;

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NINETEENTH STREET, from the south side of Capitol Avenue to the north line of Broadway;

THIRD STREET, from the south side of Capitol Avenue to the north side of Broadway;


THIRTY-THIRD STREET, from the south line of Broadway to the north line of Twelfth Avenue;


"M" STREET, from the east side of Dolores Way to the west side of Rodeo Way and from the east side of Fifty-fourth Street to the east side of Fifty-eighth Street;

TWENTY-FOURTH STREET, from the south side of E Street to the north side of Sutterville Road.
