The City Engineer's office has prepared plans and specifications for the subject project. Copy of said plans and specifications has been forwarded to the City Clerk and approval is recommended.


FINANCIAL:

In F.Y. 1976/77 the City Council approved in the City Engineer's Budget \$395,000.00, and \$50,000.00 in F.Y. 1980/81 of Gas Tax 2106 funds for the subject project. Total amount currently available for this project is \$284,375.67. The current estimated construction cost is \$273,949.25.
