**SUBJECT: EXECUTE AN AMENDMENT TO THE CONSULTANT AND
PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH HARDING LAWSON
ASSOCIATES FOR ENGINEERING SERVICES FOR THE 28th STREET
LANDFILL CLOSURE**

RECOMMENDATION:

This report recommends that the City Council approve the attached resolution authorizing the City Manager to sign an Amendment to the Consultant and Professional Services Agreement with Harding Lawson Associates (HLA) to include additional consulting engineering services related to the closure of the 28th Street Landfill. Need for additional services arose during bidding and final closure construction at the 28th Street Landfill.

Execute an Amendment to the Consultant and Professional Services Agreement with Harding Lawson Associates for Engineering Services for the 28th Street Landfill Closure

SUMMARY:

This report recommends that City Council approve an amendment to an existing Consultant and Professional Services Agreement with HLA. The amended agreement will provide additional engineering services for the 28th Street Landfill Closure. The total amount to be paid to the consultant shall not exceed \$489,621. This is a \$32,385 addition to the existing contract.

COMMITTEE/COMMISSION ACTION:

None.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

On October 4, 1995 the City executed a Consultant and Professional Services Agreement with HLA to prepare a Closure Plan Amendment for the 28th Street Landfill. A rigorous RFQ/RFP selection process preceded the selection of HLA.

Upon completion of the Closure Plan Amendment and design Plans and Specifications, the HLA contract was amended to include engineering services required during bidding and construction, inspection services during construction, and laboratory services for materials testing, preparation of as builts and certification of the final cover. This is an additional amendment for services provided during bidding and construction.

During bidding the contractor identified a source for the final cover that appeared to be improper upon visual examination. These additional services during bidding were provided to work with the contractor to test and select a proper material.

FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS:

Sufficient funds exist in the CIP YA06 (landfill closure) to fund the cost of this amendment.

ENVIRONMENTAL CONSIDERATIONS:

The closure of the landfill has undergone CEQA and a Notice of Determination was filed and posted on January 8, 1991, certifying that the project will not have a significant effect on the environment.

POLICY CONSIDERATIONS:

The closure of the landfill is consistent with the Council's commitment to support environmentally safe disposal and alternative land uses for the site.

MBE/WBE:

The original HLA contract fully satisfied the City's MBE/WBE requirements.

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SIGN SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENT # 2 TO THE CONSULTANT AND PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH HARDING LAWSON FOR ENGINEERING SERVICES FOR THE 28TH STREET LANDFILL CLOSURE
