

RESOLUTION ORDERING WORK NO. 2129.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Sacramento did, on the 4th day of November, 1926, pass its Resolution of Intention No. 2129, declaring its intention to order the following work and improvement to be done, to-wit:

That "E" Street, be produced easterly and opened to a uniform width of fifty (50) feet from the easterly boundary of "Harding Place" (as the same is filed in the office of the County Recorder of the County of Sacramento, State of California), to a point where 40th Street would intersect if the same were produced northerly. Said proposed street to be known as "McKinley Boulevard;"

That 36th Street be produced northerly and opened to a uniform width of 42 feet from its present terminus at the north boundary of the herein described "East Terrace," to the McKinley Boulevard as described aforesaid;

That 37th Street, be produced northerly and opened to a uniform width of 50 feet from its present terminus at the north boundary of the Ridgeway Terrace (as the same is shown on the official map thereof filed in the office of the County Recorder of the County of Sacramento, State of California), to the McKinley Boulevard as described aforesaid;

That 38th Street be produced northerly and opened to a uniform width of 50 feet from its present terminus at the north boundary of said Ridgeway Terrace to the McKinley Boulevard as described aforesaid;

That 39th Street be produced northerly and opened to a uniform width of 42 feet from its present terminus at the north boundary of H. J. Goethe Company's Subdivision No. 60 (as the same is shown on the official map thereof filed in the office of the County Recorder of the County of Sacramento, State of California) to the McKinley Boulevard as described aforesaid;

That San Miguel Way be produced northerly and opened to a uniform

width of 42 feet from its present terminus at the northerly boundary of Terrace Villa (as the same is shown on the official map thereof filed in the office of the County Recorder of the County of Sacramento, State of California,) to the McKinley Boulevard as described aforesaid;

That San Antonio Way be produced northerly and opened to a uniform width of 42 feet from its present terminus at the northerly boundary of said "Terrace Villa" to the McKinley Boulevard as described aforesaid;

That 40th Street be produced northerly and opened to a uniform width of 40 feet from its present terminus at the northerly boundary of W. B. Fink Subdivision (as the same is shown on the official map thereof filed in the office of the County Recorder of the County of Sacramento, State of California,) to the McKinley Boulevard as described aforesaid; and

That "D" Street be produced westerly and opened from the easterly line of San Miguel Way to the easterly line of 39th Street, if the same were produced northerly;

All being in the City of Sacramento, County of Sacramento, State of California; and describing in said resolution the lands and premises necessary to be taken therefor, and specifying in said resolution the lands to be affected or benefited by said work and improvement and to be assessed to pay the damages, costs and expenses thereof; and

WHEREAS, the Superintendent of Streets of the City of Sacramento did, thereupon, cause notice of the passage of said resolution to be posted and published for ten (10) days in the manner and as required by law; and

WHEREAS, no objections have been filed against said proposed work and improvement, and morethan ten (10) days have elapsed after the expiration of the time of the publication of said notice of the passage of said resolution, and the City Council of the City of Sacramento has acquired jurisdiction to order said work as proposed in said resolution to be done;

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby ordered that said work and improve-

ment be done as aforesaid. and as specifically described in said Resolution of Intention No. 2129.

EDWARD P. DELL, D. K. COLCLOUGH and A. J. DELANO are hereby appointed commissioners to assess benefits and damages and to have general supervision of said proposed work and improvements until the completion thereof in compliance with law.
