

ORDINANCE NO. 1163, FOURTH SERIES.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 16 OF ORDINANCE NO. 1066, FOURTH SERIES, PASSED JULY 10, 1945, AND ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE SALARIES AND WAGES OF ALL EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO, AND PROVIDING RULES FOR THE DETERMINATION THEREOF; REPEALING ORDINANCES NOS. 1026, 1031, 1045, 1047, 1052, 1053 AND 1065, RESPECTIVELY, OF THE FOURTH SERIES, AND MAKING THIS ORDINANCE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE TO TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY," BY AMENDING SUBDIVISION "ADMINISTRATIVE AND EXECUTIVE", AND MAKING THIS ORDINANCE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE TO TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1: Section 16 of Ordinance No. 1066, Fourth Series, is hereby amended by amending Subdivision "ADMINISTRATIVE AND EXECUTIVE":

ADMINISTRATIVE AND EXECUTIVE

2 Secretary, Executive City Manager \$385 mo.

SECTION 2: This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect immediately; such emergency being that due to the death of the City Manager the duties of the Executive Secretary to the City Manager have immediately increased to an unusual degree and it is therefore necessary that the salary adjustment provided for herein become effective immediately.
