

RESOLUTION No. 340

Adopted by The Sacramento City Council on date of

June 18, 1936

WHEREAS, the City of Sacramento has, or is about to, convey by grant deed to various parties certain real property in said City described as:

Lots 90, 195, 131, 289 in Swanston Park Unit No. 1, and Lots 712, 594, 459, 513, 737, 413, 497, 716, 741, 518, 713, 725, 703, 545, 612, 473, 519, 426, 609, 451, 584, 729, 661, 669, in Swanston Park Unit No. 2, and

WHEREAS, said deeds contain certain restrictive covenants coupled with reversionary rights reserved in favor of the grantor, and

WHEREAS, the grantees are each building houses thereon with a loan from the Veterans' Welfare Board of the State of California, and

WHEREAS, said Veterans' Welfare Board desires that there be assigned to it the reversionary rights of the City, and

WHEREAS, under the circumstances, it is perfectly right and proper that said Welfare Board have such reversionary rights,


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

That the Mayor and City Clerk be authorized and directed to make, execute and deliver to the said Veterans' Welfare Board an assignment of its reversionary rights for each and every of said lots,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Mayor and City Clerk be authorized and directed to make similar deeds for said reversionary rights to each and every lot conveyed by the City to grantees who will finance the building of homes thereon through the Veterans' Welfare Board.
