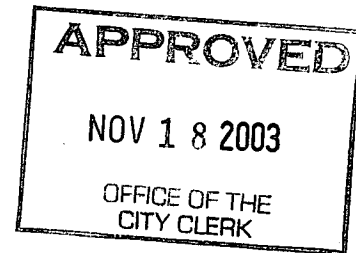

**SUBJECT: SUPPORT A PROPOSITION 40 RIVER PARKWAY GRANT FOR TWO RIVERS TRAIL AND JIBBOOM STREET PARK PHASE II**

**LOCATION AND COUNCIL DISTRICT:** Two Rivers Trail and Jibboom Street Park

Staff recommends the City Council approve two resolutions certifying the City of Sacramento has sufficient resources to develop and maintain the grant funded projects.

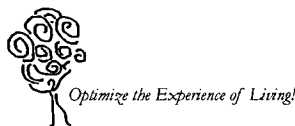

**SUMMARY:**

This report seeks City Council's approval for a \$3 million Proposition 40 grant. A grant application has been prepared by City staff. The State Resources Agency requires a specific resolution, approved by City Council, to be submitted with the grant application.

**COMMITTEE/COMMISSION ACTION:**

Not applicable.



**BACKGROUND INFORMATION:**

City staff requests Council support for two non-competitive grant projects totaling \$3 million under the California Clean Water, Clean Air, Safe Neighborhood Parks and Coastal Protection Act of 2002 from the State of California Resources Agency. This grant program, under Proposition 40, provides \$70 million for acquisition and development of river parkways.

Staff is submitting this request to Council as the State Resources Agency, which is responsible for administering the grant funds, requires a specific resolution certifying approval of an application by the applicant's governing board before submission. The resolutions are attached for Council consideration. The grant application has been completed by City staff and is ready to submit.

The Jibboom Street Park Phase II project application, at \$1.5 million, will provide funding for development of an area along the Sacramento River. Elements include large group picnic areas, a small permeable-surface parking area, and riparian planting. The site will be raised for enhanced scenic views, access to the river and Phase I area, as well as to level the site for increased access for individuals with disabilities.

The Two Rivers Trail project, also at \$1.5 million, will provide a connection between the urban waterfront in historic Old Sacramento with the American River Parkway. Development of the two-trails includes paving approximately 2.5 miles of Class I trail on the south bank of the American River and developing a vital recreation link between the Jedediah Smith Trail (in the American River Parkway), the Sacramento River Parkway, the Sacramento Northern Bikeway, Ueda Parkway, and 20<sup>th</sup> Street bike connection to the Central City.

**FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS:**

With Council support, the City will request a total of \$3 million for the two projects. There is no match required with this grant program.

The improvements developed with grant funds will be designed to be low-maintenance.

**ENVIRONMENTAL CONSIDERATIONS:**

An initial study has been prepared for the projects consistent with the requirements under the grant program. Staff will work to comply with all environmental requirements under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) once the City has officially accepted the grant and entered into a contract with the State of California.


**POLICY CONSIDERATIONS:**


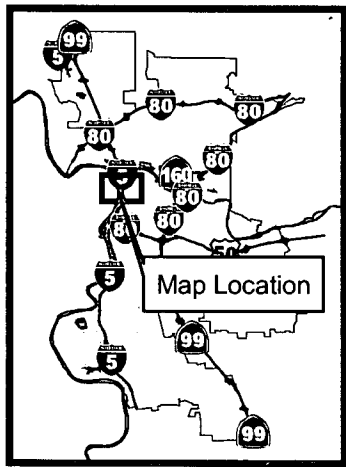


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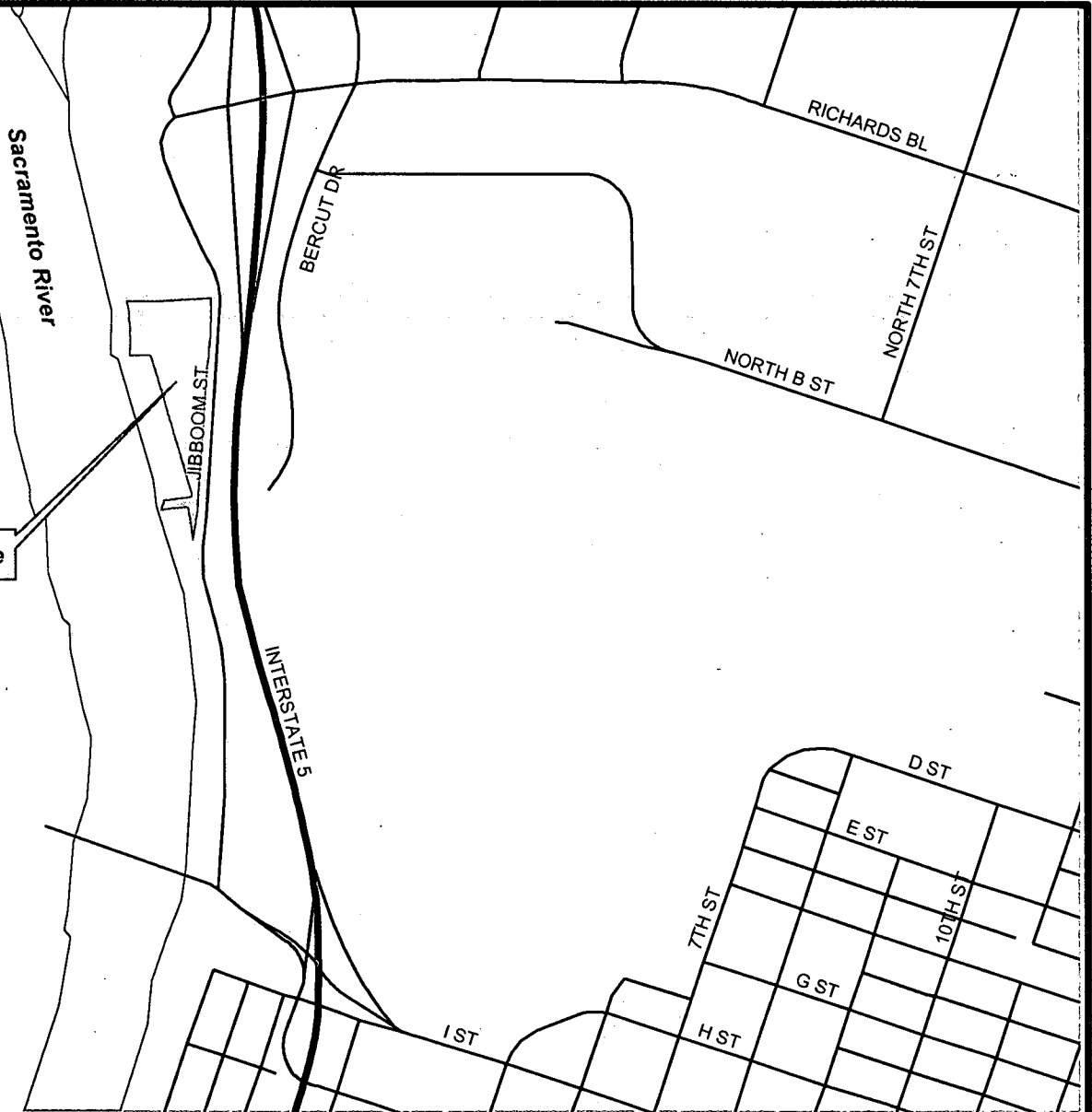


Jibboom Street Park Site

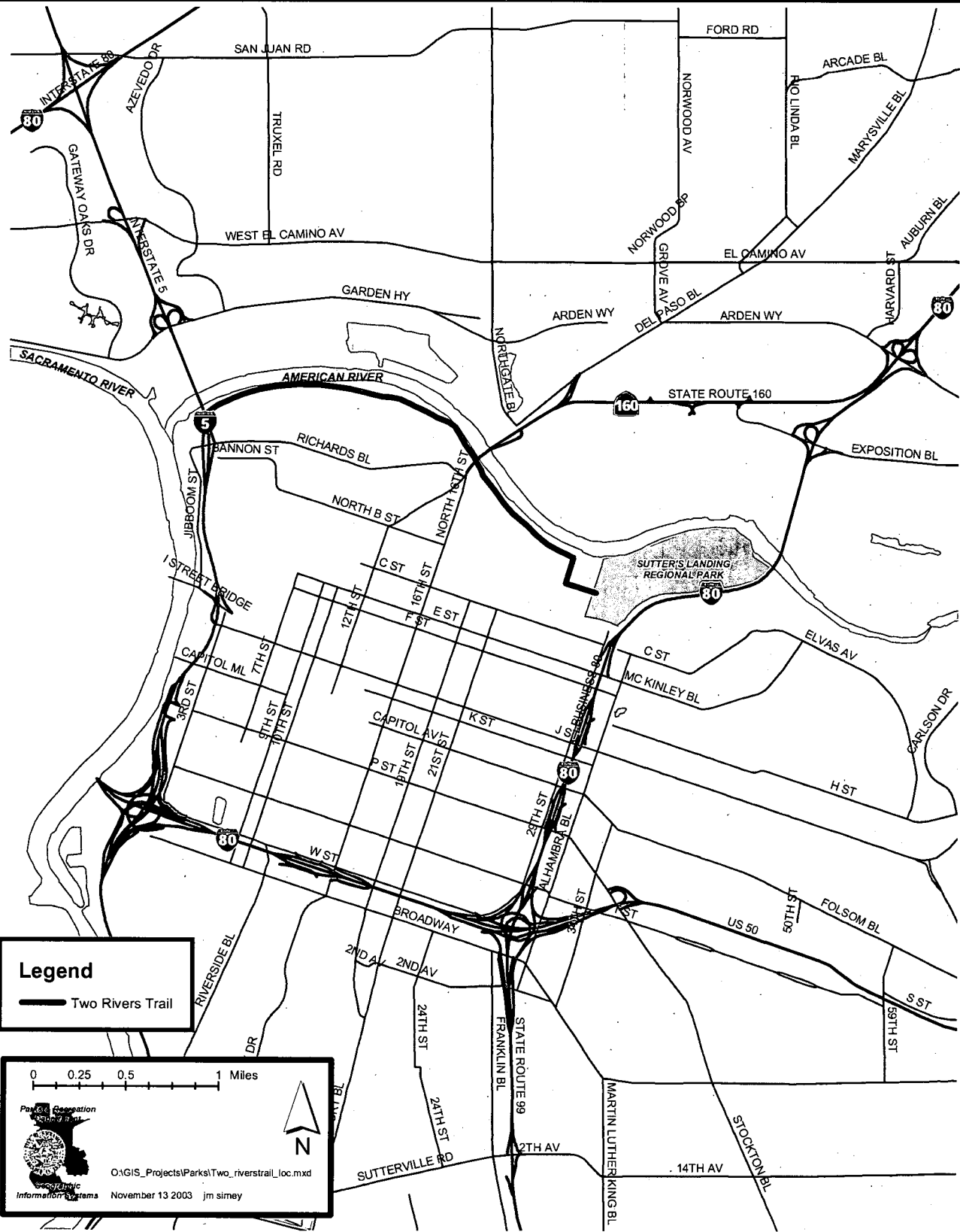

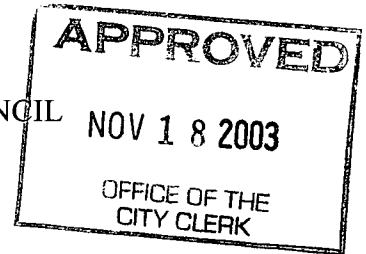
