WAGE SCALE HEARING



ABSENT: None


The Civil Service Board met in the Council Chamber, City Hall, at 8:00 o'clock P.M. for the purpose of holding public hearing relating to duties and prevailing wage scale of Garbagemen and Street Cleaning Truck Drivers. Approximately 75 citizens were present at the hearing, Thomas J. Franklin acting as court reporter.

Messrs. Anthony J. Kennedy and Albert E. Sheets, Attorneys, requested information as to the procedure which the Board would follow in the hearing. Thereafter the Secretary was requested to present such information as had been secured by the Civil Service Board office relating to this matter, after which Messrs. Albert E. Sheets, Anthony J. Kennedy, Daniel L. Milonich, S. A. Pallock, L. D. Pogetto, George Stokel, Chris Jacobsen and others presented information relating to the various duties and wage scales.

At the close of the meeting, President Deise asked the assemblage if any more information was desired to be submitted and, at the request of Attorney Sheets, the Board agreed that additional information might be submitted until October 15, 1940. There being no further information to be submitted at this hearing, it was ordered closed at 10:55 P.M.
