

ORDINANCE NO. 2029, FOURTH SERIES

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 861, FOURTH SERIES, PASSED APRIL 19, 1950, AS AMENDED, AND ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR PROCEDURE TO BE ALLOWED IN SALES BY THE CITY OF CITY OWNED REAL PROPERTY WHICH HAS BEEN ACQUIRED BY THE CITY OTHER THAN BY REASON OF SALE FOR TAXES, AND MAKING THIS ORDINANCE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE TO TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY," BY ADDING A NEW SECTION THERETO TO BE NUMBERED SECTION 6.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF

SACRAMENTO:


SECTION 1: Ordinance No. 861, Fourth Series, passed April 19, 1940, as amended, is hereby further amended by adding a new section thereto, numbered Section 6, to read as follows:


" Section 6: In instances where the City acquires title to property as the result of the abandonment of its use for park or sidewalk purposes and the Council by resolution determines that the property so acquired is not required for public use and that the value of the property does not exceed Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00), the property so acquired may be sold by the Council at private sale without advertising and without first complying with any of the other provisions of this ordinance."

SECTION 2: This ordinance shall be published once in the official newspaper of the City of Sacramento and shall take effect thirty (30) days from and after its passage.
