

ORDINANCE NO. 2050, FOURTH SERIES.

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING SECTION 4 OF ORDINANCE NO. 1283, FOURTH SERIES, PASSED MAY 9, 1947, AND ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE BUSINESS OF DEALING IN USED MOTOR VEHICLES; DEFINING USED AUTOMOBILE DEALER AND USED MOTOR VEHICLE AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURE FOR PROCUREMENT OF PERMITS TO ENGAGE IN SAID BUSINESS; FIXING THE AMOUNT OF BOND THEREFOR; PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 659, FOURTH SERIES, PASSED MAY 9, 1935," AND MAKING THIS ORDINANCE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE TO TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1: Section 4 of Ordinance No. 1283, Fourth Series, passed May 9, 1947, is hereby repealed.

SECTION 2: This ordinance is hereby made an emergency measure and shall take effect immediately; such emergency being that a similar bond is now required to be posted with the Motor Vehicle Department.
