## Recognizing the 2003 Healthy Aging Summit

**WHEREAS**, in 2001, the first Healthy Aging Summit aimed to demystify the process of aging, to inform participants that many early signs of aging are really signs of misuse and to offer practical ways to prevent and minimize debilitating long-term effects of aging; and

**WHEREAS**, Sacramento is one of our nation's most integrated communities, which creates unique challenges in overcoming cultural and linguistic barriers of our aging population; and

**WHEREAS**, in an effort to reduce cultural and linguistic barriers to health education resources, the 2002 Healthy Aging Summit targeted Sacramento's diverse aging community through a series of specially-planned events for African American, Hmong, Mien, Lao, Korean and Latino groups; and

**WHEREAS**, the 2002 Healthy Aging Summit series received national recognition from the American Society on Aging for Innovation and Quality Health Care and set a national model for outreach and service to underserved ethnic aging populations; and

**WHEREAS**, the Healthy Aging Coalition of Northern California continues its award-winning program with the 2003 Healthy Aging Summit on October 18, 2003 at Cal Expo; and

**WHEREAS**, the 2003 Healthy Aging Summit will include a healthy aging walk, keynote speakers, health education workshops, free health screenings, a multicultural art exhibit, recreation and leisure programs and a variety of entertainment.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Mayor and Council of the City of Sacramento, that we do hereby recognize the 2003 Healthy Aging Summit and encourage residents to become more informed of the issues facing older adults by participating in this event.
