This resolution is passed under and by virtue of the authority given under Ordinance No. 518, Fourth Series.


This resolution supersedes Resolution No. 602, adopted April 8 1937, as to all classifications set out herein, and all resolutions amendatory thereof.

The following rate of wages for classifications set out in said Resolution No. 602 are continued in force and effect; except classification of truck driver, which shall be as herein set out.
