

RESOLUTION OF INTENTION NO. 2718

WHEREAS, in the opinion of the City Council of the City of Sacramento, public interest and convenience require that the work and improvement hereinafter described, in the City of Sacramento, State of California, should be done;

NOW, THEREFORE, the said City Council of the City of Sacramento does hereby resolve and declare that it is the intention of the said City Council to order the following work and improvement to be done in said City, to-wit:

TO CLOSE, VACATE, and ABANDON that portion of a public street, described as follows:

Beginning at a point marking the southwest corner of Lot 23 of Block 12 of Amended Plat of Maple Park (as the same is shown on the official Plat thereof filed in the office of the Sacramento County Recorder); thence from said point of beginning North $14^{\circ} 11'$ East 108.00 feet along the westerly line of said Lot 23 to the northwest corner thereof; thence South $69^{\circ} 46'$ East 8.42 feet along the northerly line of said Lot 23 to the westerly line of Freeport Boulevard; thence by a curve to the left having a radius of 947.13 feet and whose chord bears South $3^{\circ} 47' 06''$ East 103.31 feet to a point on the easterly line of said Lot 23 (said point bears North $14^{\circ} 11'$ East 11.73 feet from the southeast corner of Lot 23); thence by a curve to the left having a radius of 947.13 feet and whose chord bears South $7^{\circ} 15' 09''$ East 12.83 feet to a point on the southerly line of Lot 22 of said Amended Plat of Maple Park (said point being South $73^{\circ} 00'$ East 4.66 feet from the southwest corner of said Lot 22); thence North $73^{\circ} 00'$ West 44.71 feet along the southerly line of said Lots Nos. 22 and 23 to the point of beginning; reserving however, the right of entry to repair maintain and construct, sewer, water, gas pipes, and aerial or underground power, telephone and other communication facilities, now in place in said Street or which from time to time may be placed therein. All proceedings in connection with the aforesaid closing are to be taken subject to such reservations and exceptions.

And said City Council does hereby determine and declare that said proposed work and improvement is of more than local or ordinary

benefit, and will affect and benefit the lands and district hereinafter described, and which said district is hereby declared to be the district affected and benefited by said work and improvement and that therefore the entire damages, costs, and expenses of said work and improvement shall be and are hereby made chargeable against, and shall be assessed upon said lands and district, which district is within the City of Sacramento, County of Sacramento, State of California, and the exterior boundaries of the lands affected and benefited by said work and improvement are particularly described as follows, to-wit:

Bounded on the North by J. C. CARLY CO. "HOMELAND", (as the same is shown on the official Plat thereof filed in the office of the Sacramento County Recorder); on the South by Markham Way; on the East by Freeport Boulevard; on the West by Lot 24 of Block 12 of Amended Plat of Maple Park (as the same is shown on the official Plat thereof filed in the office of the Sacramento County Recorder);

And the City Council does hereby elect to proceed to do said work under the provisions of Division 9 Part 3 "STREETS AND HIGHWAYS CODE THE STREET VACATION ACT OF 1941", being an Act of Legislature of the State of California, Approved May 13th, 1941; ~~being xxxxxxxx~~ and hereby fixes the 17th day of September, 1948 at 8:00 o'clock P.M., in the City Council Chamber in the Sacramento City Hall on I Street, between 9th and 10th Streets of said City, as the time and place when and where any and all persons interested in said work and improvement may appear before the said City Council of said City and be heard by said City Council upon such appeal, and show cause, if any they have, why the said Improvement should not be made.

The Sacramento Union is hereby designaged as the daily newspaper published and circulated in said City, in which this Resolution shall be published; and the Superintendent of Streets is hereby directed to post notice of the passage of this Resolution in the manner prescribed by Law.
