SUBJECT: Proposed Use Hearing - General Revenue Sharing

SUMMARY

This report regards the proposed use hearing for General Revenue Sharing funds for the 1980-81 fiscal year in accordance with Regulation 51.13(a) of the Revenue Sharing Act of 1972.

BACKGROUND

The proposed use hearing is intended to provide citizens with the opportunity to make oral and written comments regarding possible uses of General Revenue Sharing funds. The amounts of funds are \$4,820,000 for fiscal year 1980-81 and \$950,000 unappropriated in 1979-80, for a total of \$5,770,000. This hearing is being held seven days prior to submission of the 1980-81 Preliminary Budget to the Budget and Finance Committee for consideration.

A public notice regarding this hearing was published in the Sacramento Union on April 5, 1980. In addition the public notice was sent to general community organizations, organizations serving senior citizens, local newspapers, television, and radio stations. A copy of the public notice is attached.

A subsequent public hearing will be held regarding the City's proposed uses of General Revenue Sharing at the time the City Council considers approval of the 1980-81 Preliminary Budget in June 1980.

RECOMMENDATION

The staff recommends the City Council receive written and/or oral comments concerning the possible uses of General Revenue Sharing, close the public hearing,


