Subject: SEMIANNUAL WEED ABATEMENT LIEN HEARING

SUMMARY

This report recommends the City Council conduct the protest hearing for the unpaid costs of weed abatement work performed in the spring of 1987.

BACKGROUND

On June 16, 1987 the City Council established July 28, 1987 as the date to hear and consider all protests, if any, regarding the placing of the unpaid costs for weed abatement work performed in the spring of 1987 as special assessment liens on the properties where the weed abatements were performed. The City Council directed staff to notify each property owner of record of the proposed special assessment lien and the date, time, and place of the protest hearing.

DISCUSSION

On June 26, 1987 staff mailed notices of the proposed special assessment liens, including the date, time, and place of the protest hearing, to 1,109 property owners. Staff is available to assist the City Council to receive protests, to conduct an investigation of the protests, and to report the findings of fact to the City Council at its meeting scheduled for August 18, 1987.

RECOMMENDATION


It is recommended that the City Council:

1. Receive all the protests regarding the proposed special assessment liens for unpaid costs for weed abatement work performed in the spring of 1987;

- 2. Close the hearing for all unprotested, unpaid costs for abatement work performed in the spring of 1987; and
- 3. Direct staff to conduct an investigation of each protest and report the findings of fact regarding the protests to the City Council on August 18, 1987.
