That a revocable encroachment permit for the purpose of

Constructing 2" Irrigation Main to Service Planters

is hereby granted to State of California, whose
address is as follows: 1500 - 5th Street, Sacramento, CA 95814.

The encroachment area is described as follows:

Around the perimeter of the block bounded by 8th & 9th Street and P & Q
Streets 2'-0" from the property line.

This permit is granted subject to the "General Provisions -
Revocable Encroachment Permit", which were adopted by the City Council
in Resolution No. 77-611 dated October 4, 1977, and the hereinafter
specified special conditions, if any. This permit shall be effective only
after the applicant files with the Department of Finance of the City of
Sacramento, the insurance certificates required by the General Provisions.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS

1. The permittee shall comply with all requirements of the City Planning
Department and the Building Inspections Department.
2. The State agrees to hold the City harmless for any and all problems which
may arise because of the location of the irrigation main, and to pay for
all costs associated with repair, replacement and/or relocation.
3. Liability Insurance (Item 21 of the Special Provisions) is hereby waived.
