

ORDINANCE NO. 1611, FOURTH SERIES.

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO PURCHASE CERTAIN CONSTRUCTION MATERIALS AND HAVE CONSTRUCTION WORK OF BUILDING STRUCTURES FOR THE MUNICIPAL OFF-STREET PARKING PROJECT DONE BY CITY FORCES, WITHOUT FIRST ADVERTISING FOR BIDS, PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 251 OF THE CITY CHARTER, AND MAKING THIS ORDINANCE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE TO TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF  
SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1: That the City Manager is hereby authorized to purchase certain construction materials and have construction work of building structures for the Municipal Off-Street Parking Project done by city forces, without first advertising for bids, pursuant to the provisions of Section 251 of the City Charter. The estimated cost of the completion of this work is \$17000.00.


SECTION 2: This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect immediately; such emergency being the immediate necessity of completing the erection of these buildings for the Municipal Off-Street Parking Lots, so that said lots may be put into operation for parking at the earliest possible time.
