

Resolution of Award No. 2545

2545

Resolved, that the City Council of the City of Sacramento, having in open session on the 12th day of April 1946, opened, examined, and publicly declared all sealed proposals or bids offered for the doing of the street work hereinafter mentioned,

Hereby rejects all of said bids, except that next hereinafter mentioned, and hereby awards the contract for said work to the lowest regular, responsible bidder, to-wit:

To McGillivray Construction Co.

at the prices specified in their proposal for said work now on file.

The work herein referred to is the improvement of 64th Street from a point 10 feet southerly of the center line of Eastern Avenue measured at right angles to a point 36.34 feet northerly of the center line of Folsom Boulevard

in the City of Sacramento to the extent, with the materials and in the manner set forth in Resolution of Intention No. 2545, passed and adopted by said City Council on March 1st, 1946, reference to which Resolution of Intention is hereby made for a description of said work and improvement.

The City Clerk is hereby directed to publish notice of this award twice in the Sacramento Union a daily newspaper published and circulated in said City of Sacramento, as required by law.
