**SUBJECT:** Resolution Authorizing Execution of an Underground Easement to SMUD for Service to the new Fire Station located at Marysville Boulevard and Bell Avenue

SUMMARY:

Attached hereto is a resolution authorizing the City Manager and City Clerk to execute an underground easement to SMUD for service to the new fire station located at Marysville Boulevard and Bell Avenue.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

To enable SMUD to provide service connection to the new fire station located at Bell and Marysville. They are requesting an underground five (5') feet wide easement. This easement location has been reviewed by staff and found it does not interfere with existing city plans for the development of the new fire station.
