SUBJECT: Weed Abatement Public Hearing to hear and consider objections to the proposed removal of weeds, rubbish and/or dirt from various parcels of property within the City of Sacramento.

SUMMARY

This Hearing is a yearly procedure as prescribed by Section 39500, Chapter 13 of the California Government Code, titled "Weed and Rubbish Abatement". On January 19, 1982, the Sacramento City Council passed Resolution No. 82-033 declaring that certain specified parcels in the City of Sacramento have noxious or dangerous weeds, and/or rubbish, refuse and dirt; and setting February 2, 1982, for the Public Hearing as described in the foregoing paragraph.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the City Council receive the testimony of anyone with objections to the proposed abatement of said nuisances, close the hearing and refer to staff for findings of fact in this matter.

SUBJECT: Resolution declaring that certain specified parcels in the City of Sacramento have noxious or dangerous weeds of a seasonal and recurrent nature, and/or rubbish refuse, and dirt.

SUMMARY

This is the yearly procedure as prescribed by Section 39500, Chapter 13 of the California Government Code, title "Weed and Rubbish Abatement", which provides for the issuance of weed abatement notices to owners of property so described in the foregoing paragraph.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

This Resolution initiates the yearly program of the Weed Abatement Division and the real property on which said nuisances exists is described in Exhibit "A" attached to the original of this Resolution which is on file in the Office of the City Clerk, Room 203, City Hall, 915 I Street, Sacramento, California, and incorporated herin by reference.

This procedure provides that if the aforementioned lots are not abated by the respective owners a City Contractor may abate the lots at a cost determined by competitive bidding from licensed City Contractors plus an administrative charge of \$32.00 per parcel as set by Council action. Said parcels to be inspected by a Weed Abatement Inspector 48 hours before abatement is ordered. An invoice will be issued by the City of Sacramento for such abatement and non-payment can result in the cost of such abatement being placed as a lien against the property.



RECOMMENDATION



RESOLUTION NO. 82-033

ADOPTED BY THE SACRAMENTO CITY COUNCIL ON DATE OF

A RESOLUTION DECLARING WEEDS, RUBBISH, REFUSE, AND DIRT TO BE A PUBLIC NUISANCE AND ORDERING AN ABATEMENT HEARING

WHEREAS, the hereinafter described real property in the City of Sacramento is covered by weeds, rubbish, refuse and dirt; and

WHEREAS, said weeds, rubbish, refuse and dirt constitute a hazard to the health, safety and well-being of the citizens of the City of Sacramento; and

WHEREAS, Article II, Chapter 13, Part 2, Division 3, of Title IV of the Government Code of the State of California (SS39560 et. seq.) and Chapter 19 of the Sacramento City Code authorize the Council of the City of Sacramento to declare by resolution as public nuisances, and order the abatement thereof, weeds growing upon the streets, sidewalks, or private property in the City and all rubbish, refuse, and dirt upon parkways, sidewalks, or private property within the City; and

WHEREAS, the weeds growing on the hereinafter described real property are of a seasonal and recurrent nuisance;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

1. That the weeds, rubbish, refuse and dirt upon the hereinafter described real property in the City of Sacramento are hereby declared to constitute public nuisances which may be abated by the City pursuant to the above-cited sections of the Government Code and City Code.
2. That the Council finds and declares that weeds growing on the hereinafter described real property are seasonal and recurrent nuisances.
3. That the real property on which said nuisances exist is described in Exhibit "A" which is on file in the Weed Abatement office, Room 3, City Hall, 915 I Street, Sacramento, California, and incorporated herein by reference.

That the owners of said real property who have any objections to the proposed abatement of said nuisances by the City in the manner prescribed by the Government Code of the State of California and the Sacramento City Code are hereby notified to attend the meeting of the City Council to be held at 7:30 p.m. on February 2, 1982, in the Chambers of the Sacramento City Council, 915 I Street, Sacramento, California, when their objections will be heard and given due consideration.

5. That notices of said hearing shall be mailed to all persons owning property described in this resolution in the manner provided by Section 39567.1 of said Government Code, or the property shall be posted as provided by the Government code.
