**SUBJECT: BROADWAY RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT (PN:TR09) - APPROVAL OF
ENGINEERING SERVICES AGREEMENT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$110,685 WITH
PSOMAS**

LOCATION AND COUNCIL DISTRICT:

Broadway from Front Street to 10th Street. Council District 4.

RECOMMENDATION:

This report recommends that the City Council authorize the City Manager to execute the attached Consultant Services Agreement in the amount of \$110,685 with Psomas for engineering services for the Broadway Reconstruction Project.

SUMMARY:

This report requests that the City Council authorize and direct the City Manager to execute a Consultant Services Agreement with Psomas in the amount of \$110,685 for engineering services for the Broadway Reconstruction Project.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

Staff has completed the consultant selection process for engineering consulting services. A Request for Proposal (RFP) for four different Public Works projects was advertised and 7 firms responded. The consultant selection panel was composed of representatives from the City's Technical Services Division. The panel reviewed and rated the written proposals for the seven firms that responded. Four out of the seven firms were chosen, and each selected firm was matched with one of the four projects based on their scores and the project's estimated construction cost. The highest scoring firm was chosen for the project with the highest estimated construction cost.

Following are the four selected firms and the projects they were matched with:

- Martin & Kane – Youngs Heights Street Improvements
- PSOMAS – BROADWAY RECONSTRUCTION
- Mark Thomas & Company – Glenrose Avenue/Lexington Reconstruction
- Dokken Engineering – Silver Eagle Road/Mabel Sreet Improvements

The panel scored the written proposals utilizing the following evaluation criteria:

- Introduction (comprehension of project)
- Qualifications of the firm, project team, and assigned personnel
- Workplan

Overall firm rankings were based on the combined total of points received on the written proposal.

Psomas was the second highest ranked firm using the selection process and was matched with the Broadway Reconstruction Project, which has the second highest estimated construction cost. Psomas has assembled a highly qualified and experienced team to perform the engineering services needed for the project.

ENVIRONMENTAL CONSIDERATIONS

The approval of the consultant services agreement for engineering services is not considered a project as defined by Section 15378 of the California Environmental Quality Act guidelines. The activity involves no physical construction and has no potential to cause a significant impact on the environment.

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FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS:

The estimated project cost for the Broadway Reconstruction Project is \$3,612,643. Local funds in the amount of \$28,000 and State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) funds in the amount of \$120,000 have been allocated to the project for the design phase. Staff will return to Council at a future date for approval of the Program Supplement and additional local funds for the construction phase of the project.


POLICY CONSIDERATIONS:

ESBD CONSIDERATIONS:

Psomas had initially retained the services of two ESBE firms, Y&C Transportation Consultants and Espana Geotechnical Consulting. However, due to a City initiated change in the scope of work, their services are no longer needed.
